FIRE DISTRICT BUSINESS:

Meeting with County Treasurer and DNR

Representative from DNR and the County Treasurer attended the Board Meeting and gave an explanation to the Board of Commissioners regarding the error in revenue distribution. DNR gave a presentation and explanation on Trust Land and Sources of Revenue.

DNR also lead a discussion that helped clarify that the misallocated funds started in 2007 and came from a contract with the Livingston Rock Quarry. The Clark County Treasurer representative provided copies of a breakdown report of all the entities that received revenue in error. Of the total misapplied money East County Fire & Rescue is accountable for 8%.

All parties further discussed possible repayment options. It was agreed that DNR would look into possible deferment payments from future revenue, and that ECFR Commissioners would have more feedback after their upcoming amended budget meeting.

Adopt FY2019 Budget Calendar

ECFR Staff generated a budget calendar for the preparation of the 2019 year budget. There was only one revision to the deadline date for the Legal Ad, changed from September 3rd to August 31st.
